ANSWER KEY

- (1) There are fifty trees in the park. Park workers will plant 7 more today. How many trees will the park have then?

$$50 + 7 = 57$$

Answer: 57 trees

- (3) A restaurant served 33 pizzas today. It served seven yesterday. How many pizzas did it serve on both days?

$$33 + 7 = 40$$

Answer: 40 pizzas

- (2) A shelf was being held in place by thirty-five screws. Evan added nine more screws to make it stronger. How many screws are holding the shelf in place now?

$$35 + 9 = 44$$

Answer: 44 screws

- (4) Sabrina found 36 seashells on the beach. Her sister found 5 seashells. How many did they find altogether?

$$36 + 5 = 41$$

Answer: 41 seashells
